**CALL TO ORDER:** Chairperson Mayor Stark called the special meeting to order at 7:05 PM at the home of Mayor Stark, 2880 West Road.

**Winter Variance Violation on 2870 Inner Road**

Mayor Stark stated the meeting was called regarding the log home plan change from 10 inch to 12 inch logs. Councilmember Hornig moved to approve the plan change with the condition a clarification be made for two concerns:

1. The height of the home being built at 2870 Inner Road be confirmed by the surveyor.
2. The validation of the original drawing of the plans showing 8 ½-9 inch difference between the logs making it appear like regular siding.

Councilmember Newberry seconded. Motion carried 3-0.

**ADJOURNMENT**

Mayor Stark adjourned the meeting at 7:35 PM

Councilmember Hornig agreed to call the architect and the surveyor to discern the clarification. The homeowners, Michelle and Ed Winer, and the Mayor were involved with the discussion on Friday, September 17, and it was agreed to resubmit the page on the revised Plan to show Swedish Cope Logs are being used (the original plan stated Western Wood); and to also redo a laser survey to validate the height will not exceed Woodland's maximum height allowed of 35 feet. The original drawing was correct since 10 inch logs when put in place do measure 8 ½ - 9 inches.

The Red Tag was removed on Monday, September 20 and the construction can proceed.
